

## Pinewood Park Elementary School Uniform Policy

- I. **Uniform Shirts:** “Polo Style” knit shirts (Navy Blue, White, or Red)  
Shirts must have a collar.  
Pinewood Park School Spirit Shirts (Friday only)
- II. **Additional Uniform Pieces:** Must be Khaki or Navy Blue colors for both girls and boys.  
**Girls:** Skirts, Shorts, Skorts, Jumpers, Slacks, or Capri Pants.  
(No Plaids),  
**Boys:** Slacks, Shorts
- Blue jeans are not allowed for boys or girls.
- III. **POLICY:**
1. Parents enrolling a new student at Pinewood Park Elementary have two weeks to comply with the school uniform policy.
  2. Enforcement will be as follows:
    - **1<sup>st</sup> Uniform Rule Infraction:** Students will be sent to the “Clothes Closet.” Students will change to a uniform outfit. A note will be sent to parents regarding the infraction. Clothes will be returned to the clothes closet at the end of the day.
    - **2<sup>nd</sup> Uniform Rule Infraction:** Students will be sent to the “Clothes Closet.” A second note will be sent home to the parents.
    - **3<sup>rd</sup> Uniform Rule Infraction:** Parents/Guardians will be called to come to the school to correct the clothing before students may return to class.
  3. On individual school picture day, students may have a “free day.” Students may wear clothing appropriate for pictures, or uniforms. Students must follow the LISD Dress Code on picture day. On Group Picture Day, students will wear the school uniform.
  4. No Visible logos are allowed on any clothing, except PWP school logos.
  5. Spirit Days are held on Fridays. Students may wear a PWP school spirit shirt with the uniform shorts, slacks, skirts, jumpers, capri pants, or skorts.
  6. Winter coats (outer wear) do not have to match the uniform color code. Heavy winter coats will not be worn inside the school building.
  7. Students may wear sweaters or pull over sweaters inside the building. Pull over sweaters, sweaters that open in the front, or sweatshirts must match the color of uniform shirts, and be free of logos. Students may wear PWP sweatshirts or t-shirts on Friday (Spirit Day).
  8. Shoes must be suitable for PE. Tennis shoes are preferred, or black or brown leather shoes may be worn. No platform shoes, flip flops, or

- shoes without straps on the heels are allowed at any time. Shoes with shoestrings must be tied, shoestrings must be of matching colors.
9. Clothes may be only one size larger than the student wears. No sagging or bagging pants will be allowed. Shirts must be tucked in at all times for boys and girls.
  10. If pants have loops, boys and girls must wear black or brown belts.
  11. Parents may buy as few, or as many of the uniform pieces, as they feel is appropriate for the child's personal needs. The parents of each child will determine the number of pieces purchased for the student.
  12. All accessories such as socks, hair ribbons, bows, or other similar items should match the uniform color code. Long, dangling earrings, rubber bracelets, or distracting jewelry are not permitted.
  13. All LISD Dress code for acceptable clothing still applies, such as skirt and short length.

#### **IV. IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. Students who are enrolled in Pinewood Park Elementary for the 2006-2007 school year will receive information in the report card at the end of school in May of 2006.
2. A Clothes Closet will be maintained on campus. Parent volunteers and school staff will coordinate the Clothes Closets weekly during August, and monthly after that time. Donations of gently used uniforms will be accepted to build the capacity of the Clothes Closet for PWP students.
3. Families needing financial assistance may contact the school counselor. Assistance will be made in the form of a voucher, gift certificate, or a trip to the Clothes Closet. Requests will be honored on a first come - first served basis, and through available sponsors. Special emergencies or assistance may be arranged through the school Counselor.
