How to Use a <u>United Streaming Video on a Class Web</u> Page Without Violating Copyright (*Public.WWW*)

Example 1: Web Based Learning Activity (about animals):

Watch "Animal Alphabet". To watch the video click here.

- Type the assignment code that is written on the whiteboard or in your assignment notebook next to Animal Alphabet Code.
- Type your first and last name.
- Answer the assignment questions after you watch the video.

You could include the questions that you want them to answer on the web page or include the task you want them to do when finished with the video.

Idea: Have older students watch two video clips about animals and then complete a Kidspiration Venn diagram that compares and contrasts the two animals.

Below are two examples of a way to include a United Streaming Video on a classroom web page which WILL BE connected to the world wide web. (If you are including a link on a web page that will ONLY be located in SCommon then use the directions on the "United Streaming Video Links_Help Card".)

Example 2: Annotated Web Page (for parents):



3. **Background Choices:**Change the **COLOR** or **FILL EFFECTS**of the page.




4. Clicking **More Colors** brings up a larger palette of colors.




Hints: Choose light background colors. Make sure the font colors are contrasted in a way to assure readability.

5. Clicking **Fill Effects** brings up a window with several background options.

Frames



- 6. Experiment with various Color choices.
 - <u>Two colors</u> allows you to create a gradient on the page with 2 colors.
 - **Shading styles** changes the way the gradient is placed on the page.
 - <u>Varients</u> shows the various options once a Shading style has been selected.
 - <u>Preset</u> has several already designed gradients. Choose from the menu.



7. Click OK when finished.
