

# Valley View Elementary

## New Uniform Policy – 2005-06

**Color, Top: Navy, White, Red (Polo, short or long sleeve. Buttoned down collard oxford, white only, short or long sleeve.)**

**NO POCKET TEE OE TEE STYLE SHORT**

**Color, Bottom: (Boys/Girls)-Khaki, Navy (pants, shorts)  
(Girls)-Khaki, Navy – (jumpers, skirts, skorts)**

**NO CARGO OR CARPENTER STYLE PANTS WILL BE ALLOWED.**

**\*NEW UNIFORM PIECE FOR 2005-06 Color, Jacket: Navy only (windbreaker, light jacket, fleece or sweater, zipper or button only)**

**NO PULLOVERS. THIS EXCLUDES COATS (OUTERWEAR).**

**Uniform Pieces: Shirts, Jackets, Pants, Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers, and Shorts**

### **Policy:**

1. Parents enrolling a **new student to the district** will have two weeks to comply with the uniform policy.
2. Enforcement will be as follows:  
**Parents/Guardian will be called to come and correct clothing before the student can come to class.**
3. Students will be allowed a “free day” every six weeks, (Thursday, after report cards go home) Attire worn on a free day **must** comply with LISD dress code. Note: individual picture will be considered a “free day”- - students can wear clothing appropriate for pictures.
4. No visible logos will be allowed except Valley View School monogrammed logos, purchased at **Wade & Aston only**.
5. Students not complying or parents who do not want their children in a uniform can apply for a transfer to another school that has openings.
6. Coats (outerwear) will not be worn in the classroom. **Navy blue (only)** windbreaker, light jacket, fleece or sweater, with zippers or buttons, will be allowed in the classroom. **NO PULLOVERS!!**
7. Shoes should be suitable for PE Classes, (tennis shoes). Platform shoes, flip flops, opened toed shoes or sandals will not be allowed. Penny Loafers, Maryjanes or any shoe with a **closed** front and back will be permitted.
8. Clothes will be allowed to be one size larger. No sagging or bagging pants. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
9. If pants have loops, belts must be worn by boys & girls.

10. On class picture day, the principal will decide if students will have a “free day”.
11. Parents are asked to purchase one shirt of each color.
